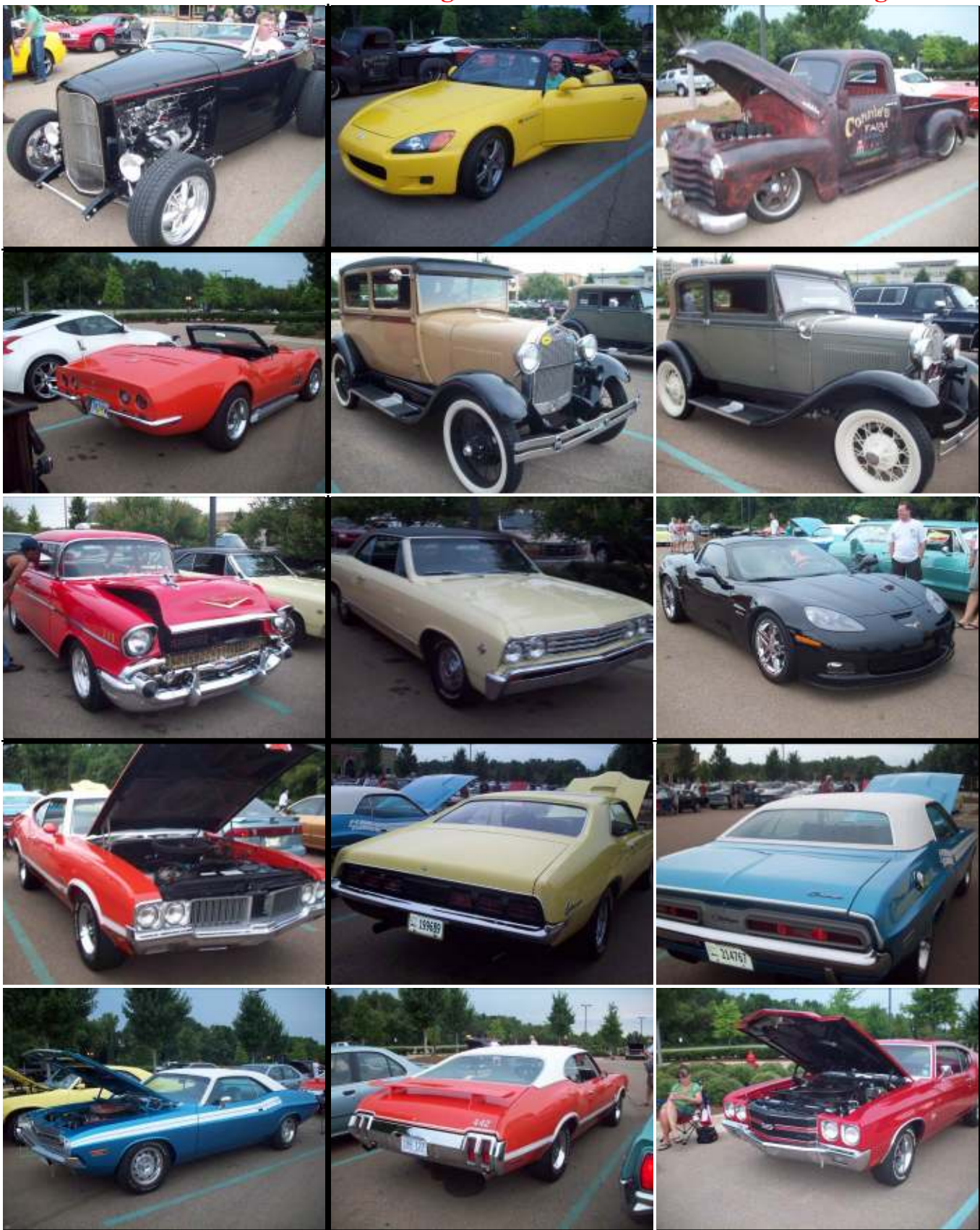

The story shown below is written by MCC member Mr. Tom Ward from Madison. Tom wrote the story after reading the story in last month's newsletter provided by MCC member Bill Kirk from Canton about the '62 Big Chief Pontiac from the former Lane -Moak Pontiac in Jackson, MS. It brought back a lot of old memories from Tom's younger days.

I graduated from Central High School, Jackson, in May 1955. That summer, I went to see Mr. Paul Moak, Sr. about a summer job. Mr. Moak and my father were good friends, and my father being a doctor who made house calls, got one of the first Pontiacs delivered after the WW2 (1945). That kept a lot of new mothers happy when dad went to take care of their babies at any time, day or night.

Mr. Moak took me into the Service Department and introduced me to Mr. Bud Graves. Mr. Graves then took me over to the Parts Department to meet Mr. Cliff Bonney, who was a gruff old man who ran a very tight ship in that

department. After 2 or 3 weeks of cleaning every part on the parts shelf, I was ready for a new assignment. Mr. Graves asked me what I wanted to do now, and I told him "anything but cleaning parts".

Bud Graves and I became close friends when he told me I could be the Courtesy Car Driver. I also drove pretty ladies to work, home or anywhere else they needed to go. In addition, I made the weekly trip to the bank on Friday to get lots of cash to give to the workers that wanted cash instead of a paycheck. I made \$35 a week.

The next summer, I got my old job back, while home from college. I was making \$45 a week. That was 1956. Sometime later that year, I was home for Thanksgiving Break and I went to see Bud. He had just gotten his personal '56 Catalina 4-door sedan, two-toned green, but with the biggest "Daytona Engine" that he could order. He knew that I was a "car nut" and asked me if I wanted to take his car out on Friday night. What would you do? It was right after all the '57 hot new cars hit the street and all the car salesmen were out showing off the '57 Chevys, Dodges, Fords, and Chryslers. I gathered a few friends and we went "hunting" the stoplight drags from one end of town to the other. We blew away every car we met by a half a block. Never got caught and I returned the car to him without a scratch. What a great night.

Mr. Moak, Sr. and Bud Graves were two of the nicest people I have ever known. I am going to see Bud in Raymond as soon as possible. Thanks for letting me share this with you.

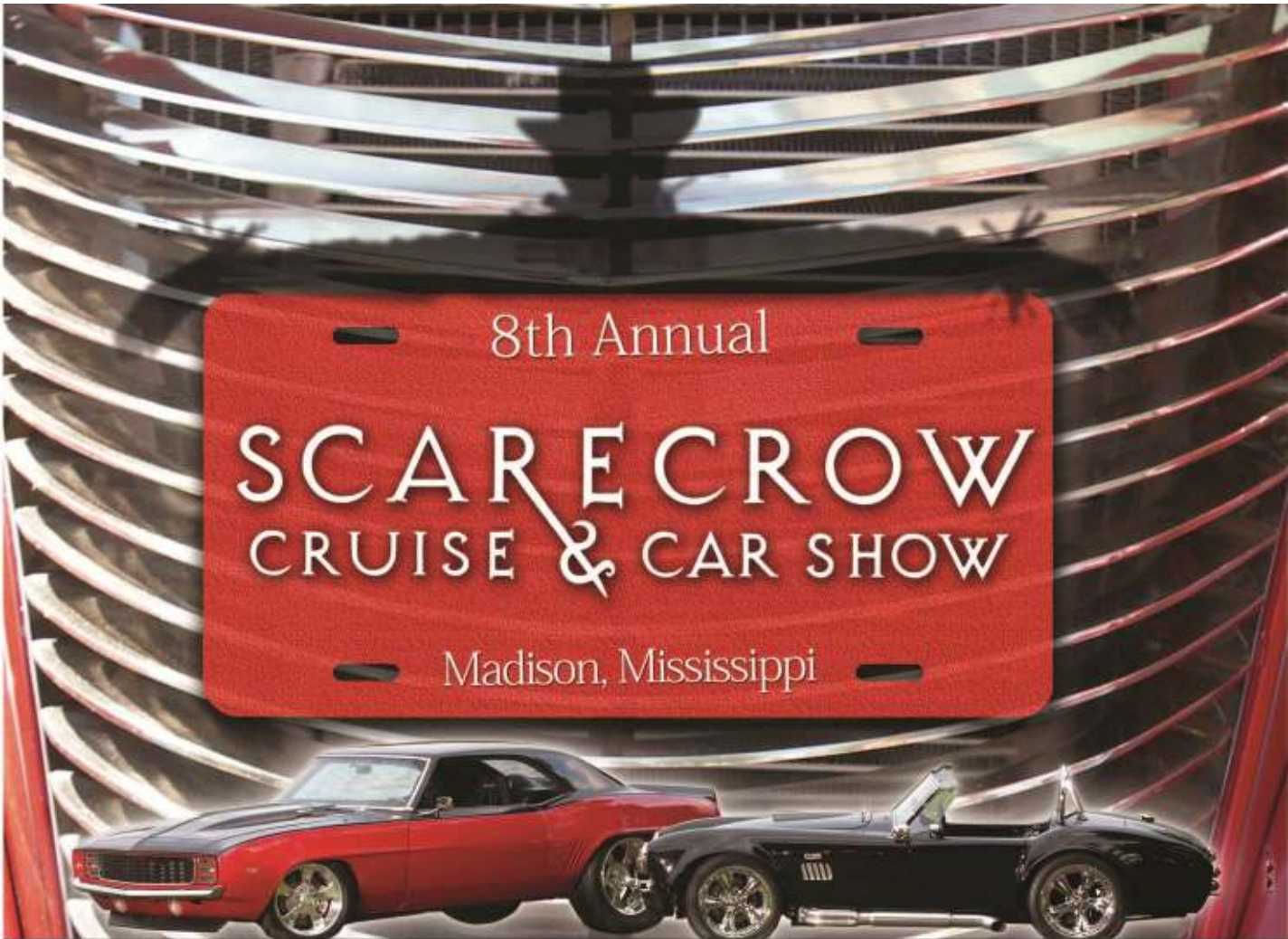

Door Dings Got You Down?

This is a reprint from the September 2010 newsletter by special request. Have you ever walked out of a building admiring your beautiful car across the parking lot and as you got closer all you could focus on is the ding in one of your quarter panels? The countless hours to make that quarter panel absolutely perfect and there sits that ding. **Doesn't that dent just drive you crazy!** That's what happened to me. That

ding in the quarter panel of my shiny black Lexus put there by some careless boob was taking the fun out of cleaning up my car. After several months of trying to ignore the dent I had enough and decided to take care of the problem. If you have never used the paintless dent repair services you have got to give it a try. I am here to tell you that it works and works well. I called MCC member Jason Cheney, owner of National Dent, to see if he could help. Jason came out to my house in Madison with his tools and special light and within 5 minutes the dent was gone!! I mean not even a trace that the dent was ever there. All that fuming for months and all I have to do is call Jason. That's not the end of the story. While Jason was in my garage we found a couple of dings in the hood of my red '63 Chevy Impala that were missed when my car was last painted back in 1982. And after 6 minutes these too were gone. Next came my daughter's Olds Alero and my wife's Nissan with several dings in the doors. Ten more minutes and these too were gone. In about 20 minutes all four cars were made dent free. Even if the paint is slightly scratched you can still get the dent taken out and then use a dab of touch up paint. With the dent removed the touch up paint should do the job. A typical dent removal is about \$50 for the first dent and additional dents will generally cost less. The best value is to line 'em up and get all your vehicles fixed during his visit. Jason does a lot of work for local body shops and car dealers and will be more than happy to come to your house to make all your cars and trucks DENT FREE.
